THE LEAGUE CLUB DONATES \$5,000 TO DAVID LAWRENCE CENTER CHILDREN'S PROGRAM

David Lawrence Center and Foundation are pleased to announce that The League Club, Inc. has recently awarded a \$5,000 grant to support the Juvenile Substance Abuse Intervention Program. The intervention program addresses the substance abuse needs of youth ages 12-17 whose substance use has become problematic. This eight week group therapy program offers short term counseling, random drug testing and education on chemical dependency.

Through their generosity, troubled teens battling substance abuse problems will get the help they need to turn their lives around and protect their futures."
